

UNITED KARNATAKA CHESS ASSOCIATION(UKCA)

FINANCIAL REGULATIONS

The revenue of the UKCA will Include

1. Annual Affiliation Fee

Each affiliated District association shall pay to the UKCA Rs./- (Rs. Two Thousand Only) and for Academies Rs.2500/-between 1st & 15th of April or with a fine of Rs.500/- before 30th April of that year.

2. Players Registration Fee

Life Membershp Fee of Rs.1000/(Rs.One Thousand Only)
Temporary Fee of Rs.50/ per player per tournament (applicable only if not a Life member)

3. Arbitors Registration Fee

Annual Affiliation Fee of Rs.500 to be paid for officiating in UKCA tournaments.

4. Recognition Fee for State / District / Corporate Tournaments

5. Entry Fee Regulation for various Tournaments.

The Organisers of various tournaments/championships shall charge entry fee from players as per the below table.

1. Rating Tournaments - As per AICF/FIDE specification
2. Open one day Tournaments - Rs.700
3. Interschool Tournaments - Rs.500
4. State Level Rating Tournaments – 1% of Prize Money or Rs.2500 whichever is lower.

6. Arbiters Remuneration

Apart from the above, the Chief Arbitr shall be reimbursed to & fro 2nd AC train fare, free Board & lodge apart from local transportation.

Apart from the above, the Deputy Chief Arbiters shall be reimbursed to & fro 3rd AC train fare, free Board & Lodge apart from local transportation.

7. Player's Participation in National Championship (Effective from April 2020)

(i)Each Selected Player who has been representing in the National Championship shall be paid Rs.2500/- as conveyance charges.

(ii) The player shall be eligible and can apply for Concessional 3AC Class Train from home town to Championship and back.

(iii) The normal entry fee for the National Championship shall be borne by the organizer of the state championship.

(iv) Dress Code: Minimum 2 T-Shirts each (with the Association name) shall be supplied to all the players who are representing the state. For the normal entry the Association shall bear the cost and Special entry the the cost of the T-shirts shall be collected from the concerned player.
