- This Tournament is open only for Indian citizens and Karnataka Residents who are born on or after 01/01/2001.
- Top 2 players will be selected to National U-17 chess championship.
- The tournament will be played on Swiss-league under latest FIDE rules.
- UKCA Registration is mandatory for all players.
- Latest FIDE Tie-break rules will be applicable in case of a tie.
- Protests, if any against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be lodged in writing with a protest fee of Rs.500 within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident.
- Organizers have the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason thereof.
- Participants must submit a valid date of Birth certificate.
- Players and accompanying people are requested to make their own food and accommodation arrangements.
