In celebration of our Silver Jubilee a multidisciplinary sports tournament to be held from the 19th to the 21st of August 2019 at our [GEAR Gurukul Campus](#).

CHESS Tournament : RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Tournament will be held for Boys & Girls studying up to Class 12 following any recognised board (ICSE/CBSE/IB/IGCSE/SSLC). The number of rounds will be decided depending on the number of Teams/players participating.
- The Event is being conducted in the Categories as below:
 - 1) Category 1 – comprising of Children studying in Class 2 and below.
 - 2) Category 2 – comprising of Children studying in Classes 3 and 4.
 - 3) Category 3 – comprising of Children studying in Class 5 and below.
 - 4) Category 4 – comprising of Children studying in Classes 6 and 7
 - 5) Category 5 – comprising of Children studying in Classes 8 to 12.
 - 6) Team Event – comprising of four Open Teams and four Girls Teams from each School.
- Time Control is 15 minutes + 5 seconds increment each.
- Entry Fee for Individual Event is Rs 500/- per player (550 for Non UKCA Players) and the same may be paid by August 16th, 2019 through www.paychessentry.com. Entry Fee for Team Event is Rs 1600 (A Team will comprise of 4 players). A school may register up to 20 participants (10 Boys and 10 Girls) in each category for the Individual Event. However, the Organizer reserves the right to close the entries once the limit is reached. It is therefore recommended Schools register at the earliest for participation in the Individual Categories. Two separate Events are listed on Paychessentry.com GEAR Sports Fest - Individual and GEAR Sports Fest - Team. Participants should register correctly in the corresponding Event and the Organiser is not responsible for any incorrect registration by the participants/participating Schools.
- Children of Categories 1, 2 and 3 will have their Individual Event on August 19, 2019. Children belonging to Categories 4 and 5 will have their Individual Event on August 20, 2019. Children from lower Categories can take part in higher categories. The Team Event will take place on August 21, 2019. Each School is permitted to send a total of 4 Open (Boys and Girls Mixed) Teams and 4 Girls Teams only for the Team Event on August 21, 2019.
- Participants are required to come in their school uniform with their School ID cards – accompanied by their Manager/Coach. A letter attested by the Principal with the names of the participants should be carried by the Team Manager/Coach.
- Top 3 Players in each Category of the Individual Events will be awarded Trophies with merit certificates respectively. If a Category receives more than 80 entries, the organiser reserves the

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right to split the category into two sections. 3 Trophies each will be awarded to each Section in such a scenario. The Chief Arbiter will decide on the players in each Section.

- Top 3 Teams in the Team Event will be awarded a Trophy each (Winner, 1st and 2nd Runner Up Trophies). The top 3 players in each Board will be recognised as well along with Merit Certificates.
- Lunch is provided to Team Officials only. Participants should bring their own lunch boxes. Parents are not allowed inside the School Campus. Only the School Officials mentioned in the School attested letter are permitted.
- Participation Certificates will be provided to all the Players.
- The Chief Arbiter for the individual events is Mr Saleem Beig and the Chief Arbiter for the team event will be Vasanth B H.
